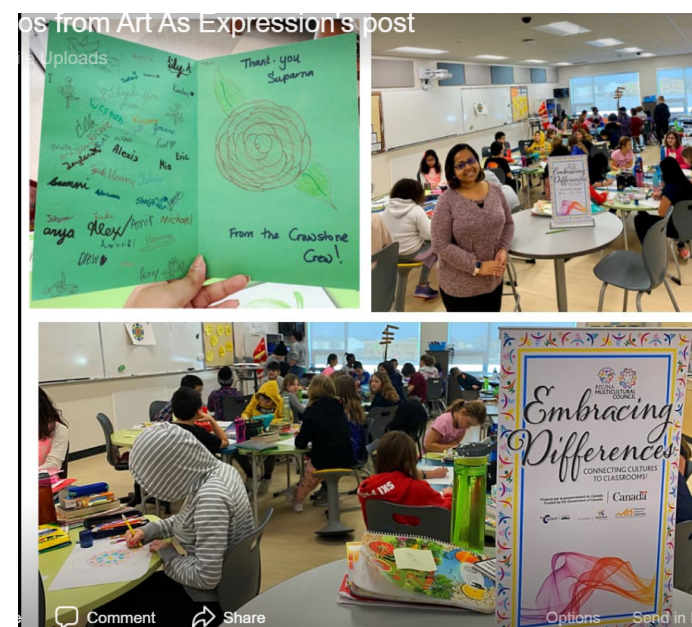




## Call for 2021/22 Cultural Ambassador Applications



The Regina Multicultural Council is seeking cultural ambassadors to support the third cycle year of the Embracing Differences Outreach Project. The project aims to connect cultural ambassadors with participating Grades 5-8 classrooms in Regina Public and Regina Catholic School Divisions to provide students and teachers the opportunity to engage in ongoing cultural learning experiences.

Due to overwhelming success in providing for nearly 200 cultural workshops in 2020/21, we are seeking to expand both the number of cultural ambassadors and the number of cultures represented to meet increased 2021/22 classroom requests. Cultural ambassadors are welcome to participate as personal schedules allow.

Providing a cultural ambassador from your community will help ensure representation in this extraordinary project so that students and teachers may learn directly from a trusted source and potentially engage those seeking to learn more about your cultural community's programming in Regina.

- \*Highly knowledgeable about their culture or cultural area
- \*Experienced working with children and youth
- \*Endorsed with a letter of support from the culture's community leadership
- \*Able to provide current satisfactory Criminal Record and Vulnerable Sector Checks
